Renewable natural gas is made by capturing methane from food waste, agricultural manure, landfills, and wastewater treatment plants. There are more than 200 farms and 1,200 waste water facilities in America using anaerobic digesters to create renewable natural aas.5



The natural gas industry employs nearly 2 million Americans and is expected to add 3.5 million jobs by 2035.6
